Clothing and footwear

To ensure a safe and enjoyable visit, please ensure suitable clothing and footwear is provided for your child/ren as they will be looking around a working site and will not be allowed to tour the site if they do not have practical clothing and footwear.

Full-length bottoms must be worn, as well as sensible and sturdy shoes with covered toes. When taking part in river activities, wellies must be worn. Under no circumstances, can sandals or flip-flops be worn around any of our sites.

As we tour our sites during rain and shine, please ensure waterproofs and/or suncream are provided as required.

Wessex Water can provide the high vis jackets for children and staff, if needed.



Food and drink

Other than water for drinking bottles, Wessex Water will not provide any food or drink for pupils, so please ensure they bring a packed lunch. Each site has designated areas for eating and hand sanitiser and/or soap and water will be available and should be used prior to eating.
